ACIP & CDC Guidelines for L&D and Newborn Nursery Units

**AFTER DELIVERY**  
Recommendation: Administration of Birth Dose Hepatitis B Vaccine and Hepatitis B Immunoglobulin (HBIG) to be given within 12 Hours of Birth

<sup>3</sup> Because of the potential for decreased immunogenicity of vaccine in preterm infants weighing <1,000gms, the birth dose vaccine should not be counted as part of the 3 doses required to complete the HBV vaccine series. A total of 4 doses should be given.

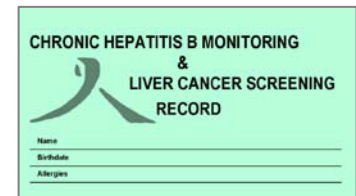
